#### **OUR ISSUES OF CONCERN**

- Tourism's threats to indigenous people and cultures especially in Asia Pacific region rich in cultural diversity and indigenous groups.
- Marine and terrestrial degradation and environmental footprints from mass production and consumption.
- Exceeding carrying capacities in ecologically sensitive areas (Over-tourism)
- Greenwashing in the tourism industry.
- Lack of political will to protect environment and cultures from impacts of tourism vis-à-vis revenue.

- \* Be conservation advocates protecting marine and terrestrial ecosystems and biodiversity.
- \* Promote community entrepreneurship through empowerment, skills transfer and capacity building.

Accommodation Recognized by Global Sustainable Tourism Council



Asian Ecotourism Standard for Accommodation (AESA) finalised and available in eight (8) regional languages.

\* Six Themes with 123 criteria and corresponding indicators

1. Sustainability

- 2. Food and beverage
- 3. Waste management and recycling
- 4. Energy and water
- 5. Green purchasing, and
- 6. Care for environment

AESA is available in eight regional languages translated by AEN board members – English, Hindi (India), Traditional Chinese, Simplified Chinese, Bahasa Malaysia, Khmer (Cambodia), Lao and Vietnamese.

AEN's in-person training classes combine classroom sessions (trainer presentations, group discussions, exercises) and hands-on learning opportunities (guest presentations, live Q&A, field session), focused on practical insights into the GSTC Criteria, and tangible action steps to applying the Criteria.

#### **AEN Certificate of Completion in Sustainable Tourism**

AEN has a MoU to conduct an authorized training under GSTC STTP. The training participants who complete a 3-day onsite STTP training class will be handed a certificate of completion of the training.





We, over 40 experts and participants from different countries and regions in Asia and Asian Ecotourism Network (AEN) participated in ecotourism forum themed "Redefining Ecotourism Seasonality" - the Semi-Annual General Meeting of AEN in Xiling Snow Mountain, Chengdu, China, from January 7th to 9th, 2020. Through extensive and indepth exchange of views and discussion of all representatives, the Declaration on Xiling Snow Mountain was unanimously adopted.


